- This program addresses a safety issue that occurs when the camera is connected to the AC power adapter or HP R-series docking station and when a single use, non-rechargeable battery, such as a Duracell CP-1, is installed in the camera. In this case the camera will attempt to charge the non-rechargeable battery which may cause overheating and possibly fire. HP is aware of only a single incident.
- The issue does not occur when using the HP supplied R07 Li Ion rechargeable battery, however all consumers are strongly encouraged to update their camera to prevent future issues if any non-rechargeable battery is used.
