



Project 2 – ID Tags

Materials

- Card stock
- Photo laminating sheets
- 7-in ball chain or craft satin cord
- Hole punch
- Scissors

Instructions

1. Select and print your design on a piece of card stock. Allow to dry completely.
2. Write in your info and then cut out the ID Tag.
3. Using the center line as your guide, fold the tag in half.
4. Following the instructions provided with the laminating sheets (or other laminating device), laminate the tag.
5. Trim the extra laminate off the edges and punch a hole in the guide on the artwork.
6. If you are using a ball chain, feed it through the hole, and attach the tag to any item you wish. If you're using the satin cord, cut an 8-in length and knot the ends together. Feed the unknotted end through the hole, pull through about an inch, and push the knotted end through the loop. Pull the knotted end until you have made a slipknot. Attach the tag with another slipknot.

Hang on backpacks, gear bags, winter coats—anything you want to ID!
